### **AJPAS Author Instruction**

**• Submission of Manuscripts:**

1. Manuscripts must be previously unpublished and should not be under simultaneous consideration by another journal.
2. The authors should also declare if any similar work has been submitted to or published by another journal.
3. By virtue of the submitted manuscript, the corresponding author acknowledges that all the co-authors have seen and approved the final version of the manuscript.
4. The corresponding author provides all co-authors.

● **Electronic submission of manuscripts:**

1. Manuscripts can now be submitted electronically via ([academysci88@gmail.com](mailto:academysci88@gmail.com)). Electronic submission saves time and postage costs, and allows the manuscript to be handled in electronically throughout the review process.
2. Upon acceptance of the manuscript for publication, authors are required to provide the original copy of the assignment of copyright dully signed by all authors.

● **Manuscript preparation:**

1. The type of the submitted article should determine the manuscript structure. However, the general structure for the manuscript should follow the **IMRAD** structure.
2. Manuscripts including tables, references and figure legends, must be typed written (double-spaced) on size A4 paper, with margins of at least (2.5 cm).
3. Pages should be numbered consecutively, beginning with the title page and continuing through the last page of typewritten material.
4. One original and three photocopies of the entire manuscript should be submitted along with four sets of photographs.
5. Manuscripts and figures for review will not be returned to authors whether the editorial decision is to accept revise, or reject. The only exception will occur when the editor returns a manuscript with handwritten editorial suggestions to authors to aid them in making revisions.
6. Manuscripts must be accompanied by a covering letter signed by the author and all co-authors.

## **I-Title page:**

The title page must contain:

1. The title should be concise and informative.
2. Clearly indicate the given name (s) and family name (s) of each author and check that all names are accurately spelled.
3. Present the authors' affiliation address (Where the actual work was done) below the names.
4. Provide the full postal address of each affiliation, including the country name and the e-mail address of each author.
5. Clearly indicate who will handle correspondence at all stages of refereeing and publication, also post-publication. Ensure that the E-mail address is given and that contact details are kept up to date by the corresponding author.

## **II-Abstract:**

1.A concise and factual abstract is required. All original articles must contain a structured abstract of not more than 250 words. The following are typical headings: Objectives (back ground), Methods, Results and Conclusion.

## **III-Keywords:**

1.Immediately after the abstract, provide 4-6 Keywords (avoiding general and plural terms and multiple concepts).

## **IV-Introduction:**

1.Introduction should always include the objective of the work and provide an adequate back ground, avoiding a detailed literature survey or a summary of the results.

### **V-Materials and Methods:**

1. Provide sufficient detail to allow the work to be reproduced. Methods already published should be indicated by a reference, and the modification should be described.

### **VI-Results:**

1. Results should be clear and concise.

### **VII-Discussion:**

1. The discussion should explore the significance of the work's results. Avoiding the repetition of the results and extensive citations.

### **VIII-Conclusion:**

1. The conclusion needs to summarize the content and purpose of the article to help the reader understand why your research should matter to them after they have finished reading the article.

### **IX-Acknowledgment:**

1. The authors wishing to acknowledge the people who're supported and helped them. It would also be perfectly acceptable to address each person individually and more personally.

### **X-References:**

1. References should be numbered consecutively in the order in which they are first mentioned in the text, not alphabetically.

2. References must be highlighted in bold throughout the text of the manuscript.

3. All references must be cited in the text or tables. Where references are cited in tables only, the first reference number used in the table should follow on numerically from the last reference number used in the main text of the article.

- II. Acknowledging Other Sources

Properly crediting previous works and their authors is a fundamental obligation for all authors. Accurate citation of others' data, ideas, and opinions are essential, and paraphrasing a cited work with identical wording is considered plagiarism. Plagiarism and self-plagiarism are grave misconducts that can lead to manuscript rejection.

### III. Fraudulent Submission

Authors must confirm that their manuscript has not been previously submitted or published elsewhere. The submission of a paper already published or under review elsewhere should be avoided under all Authors are discouraged from using honorary, gift, or ghost authorships for any reason. All genuine contributors should be included in an agreed-upon order, and all co-authors should possess a thorough understanding of the submitted data and its interpretation. It is highly recommended to acknowledge all direct or indirect substantial contributions that have impacted the study.

Animal research should conform to relevant laws and guidelines established by a formal animal research ethics body. Research involving biological materials should employ sustainable approaches. Authors involving in medical and/or biological research must adhere to the Principles of Human Experimental Techniques (Russell & Brunch, 1975) and/or the Code of Ethics in Research

(The Ethical Guide for Implementing Health Research at Institutions of Ministry of Health, Iraq, 2018).
